

Montgomery County Farm Bureau
Scholarship Program Guidelines

- 1) The County Board of Directors will appoint a Scholarship Committee.
- 2) An individual may apply more than one year.
- 3) County Board may give up to four \$1,000.00 scholarships per year to qualified applicants. The County may elect not to give a scholarship at any time.
- 4) The scholarship will be promoted at the county annual meetings and in county newsletters. Information on rules will be distributed to guidance counselors, agricultural teachers, and local extension offices.
- 5) **Applicant must:**
 - Fill out application form and mail to:

 - Be a graduating senior from or a graduate of a Montgomery County High School.
 - Be accepted to or enrolled in a college or university.
 - Attach to your application a letter to the Montgomery County Farm Bureau Board of Directors including the following:
 - Financial Need
 - Agricultural Background
 - Career Goals
 - Why you should be considered for this scholarship.
- 6) Preference will be given to applicants pursuing agricultural degrees.
- 7) Deadlines: April 25th, 2022-Application **MUST BE RECEIVED** by the County Farm Bureau.
May 04th, 2022-Winner announced.
May 10th, 2022-Scholarship funds available for dispersal.
- 8) The checks will be mailed to the college or university of the winning applicant(s) or applied to account for the book store.
- 9) The scholarship does not have to be offered every year, nor awarded after being offered, if a suitable applicant(s) is not found. The Board of Directors is charged with the responsibility of preserving the monies for worthy recipients.
- 10) Scholarships will be awarded on a non-discriminatory basis without regard to race, color, religion, national origin, sex, marital status, or disability.
