February – Distribute applications to Blacksburg High School, and Dayspring Christian Academy.

March 15 - Check with guidance counselor

April 30 – Closing date for receipt of applications. Application must be postmarked on or before <u>April 30</u> or hand delivered to Jeananne Dixon Bame on or before April 30.

- Mid-April Contact BHS and DCA to learn the dates of their senior awards programs. A representative from Mt. Tabor Ruritan Club will make the presentation of the intention to award the scholarships.
- April Ruritan scholarship committee convened to select scholarship winners
- May 1 -- Winners must notify Jeananne Dixon Bame of proof of enrollment in the post-secondary institution of their choice. Funds will not be released unless proof of enrollment is received by this date or as soon as possible after this date.

## Extra-curricular and community activities

Scholarship winners must have at least 100 hours of acceptable volunteer work within the past 24 months. Any volunteer work will be considered except for the following:

- 1. Paid or stipend service
- 2. Lobbying
- 3. Religious instruction
- 4. Conducting worship services
- 5. Engaging in any form of proselytizing
- 6. Efforts directed to serve only a family member

- 1. A letter from you telling about yourself, explaining your educational goals, and why you feel you need financial aid. The letter should be type-written, double spaced, and at least one full page.
- 2. A list of your extra-curricular and community activities, including hours of volunteer service.
- 3. A copy of your high school transcript(s).
- 4. Two letters of reference.

Selection will be made on community volunteer service, scholarship, extra-curricular activity, and perceived need. Awardees must be seniors graduating from a <u>high school or home school in Blacksburg and living in a Blacksburg zip code area</u>. Preference will be given to but not necessarily limited to residents of the Mt. Tabor community with applications accompanied by a letter of reference from a Mr. Tabor Ruritan member. Winners will be announced in early June.
